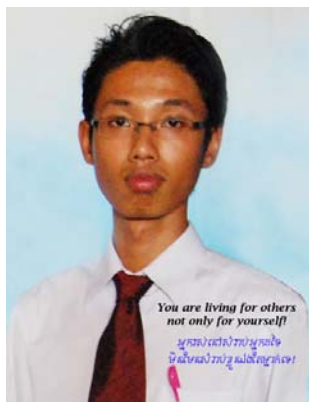


Sopheha TUM Biography
